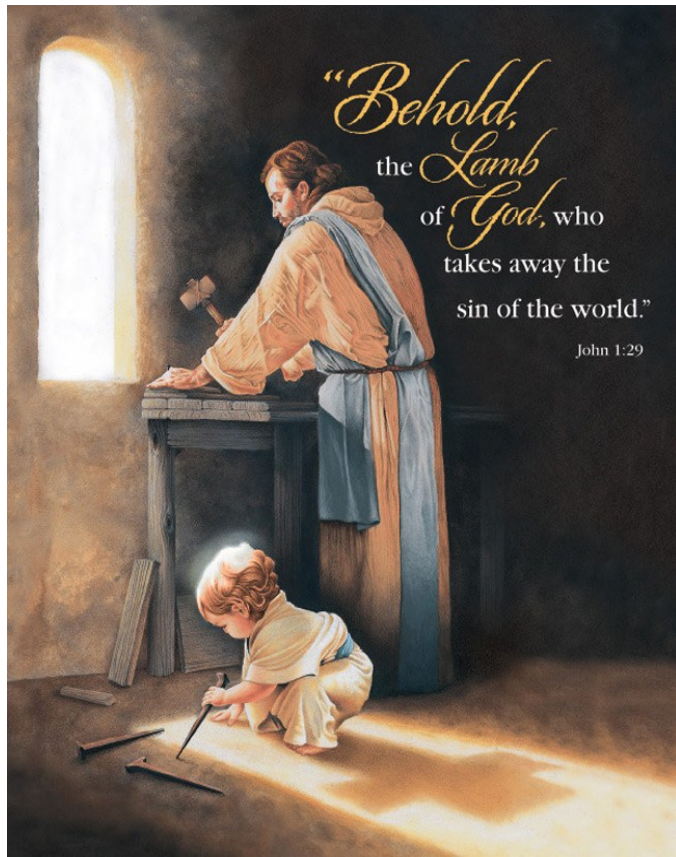

Lunch Group

Ryan has started a lunch group for high school boys and has been going through a book to discuss questions these kids have about God, life, and faith. These students have had some great questions and are truly considering the cost of becoming a Christian.

First Grade Bible Class

In first grade, we have been studying the life of Jesus and how He calls us to be His followers. Four first graders decided that they wanted to follow Jesus through this discussion. I see this not necessarily as them getting saved, but a spiritual decision that may be salvation or simply a greater awareness in desire for relationship with Jesus. The thing that matters is that they are continually taught and reminded of the gospel as they grow and are provided opportunities to surrender all for Jesus.

"You have signed up to finish the hardest part of the Great Commission..." ~David Garrison (Missions Research Expert)

To us who are co-heirs with Christ!

What is the hardest part of the Great Commission? It is the 7,000 people groups in the world today who still have less than 2% Christian witness around them. In essence, it is finishing the Great Commission. These people are Muslims, Hindus, Buddhist or Communist and usually don't have good relations with the United States. Church, my goal for this letter is to be very real with y'all in what burdens my heart. There is a real peace that come when we live in the Light. But the reality is that 40% of the world's population still live in darkness. But there is hope for **"the people walking in darkness have seen a great light, on those living in the valley of the shadow of death, a light has dawned" (Isaiah 9:2).**

Today missionaries are seeing the most Muslims turn to Christ in history! The Holy Spirit is blowing over the Muslim world and I am humbled that we are apart of it! But there is still much work to do!

"Where there is no vision, people perish." Prov. 29:18

As the new year of 2015 is here, many adjustments have happened to our team in NYC. The biggest is getting better vision for how God wants us to go about this task of starting churches amongst un-reached people. Therefore, we have decided to narrow our focus from reaching South Asians to specifically reaching Pakistanis! We hope with this narrowing we will be able to invest deeply within the Pakistani people and be able to better minister to both spiritual and physical needs. How can you get more involved in the hardest part of the Great Commission?

"The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. ASK THE LORD of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." Luke 10:2

PRAY. PRAY. PRAY! The reality is there are many people ready to hear about Jesus, but there aren't enough Christians sharing. Jesus said pray for workers! Pray that we will all be workers in the harvest field. The task is too massive for only a few workers, we need more!

Shoebox Thank You

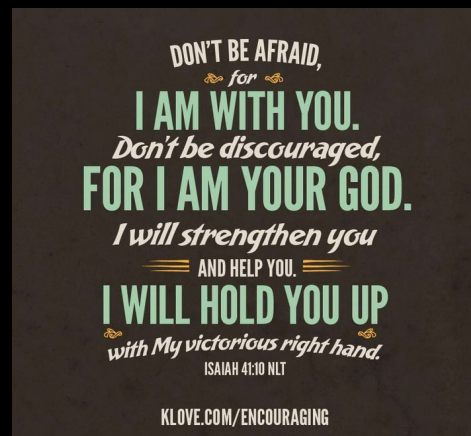
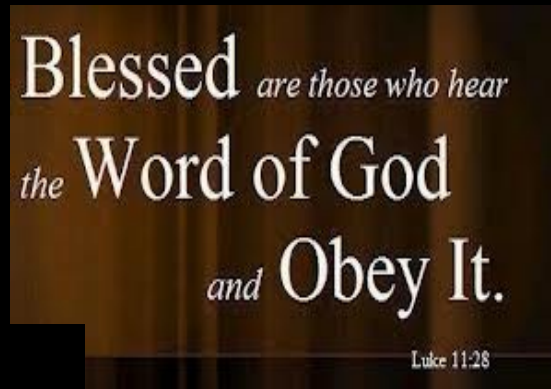
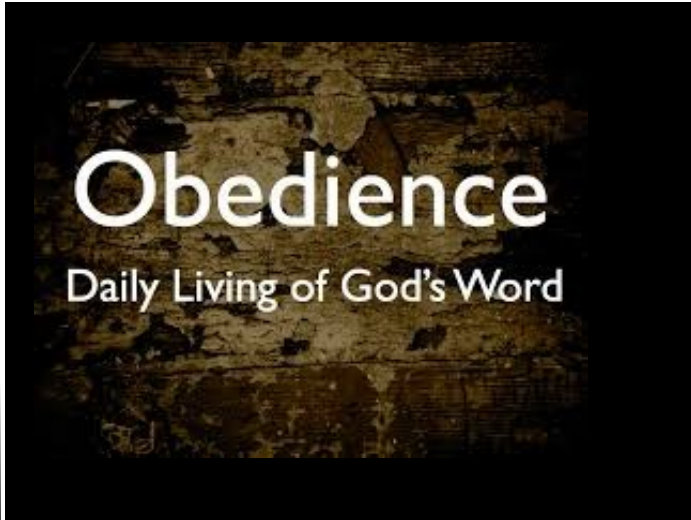
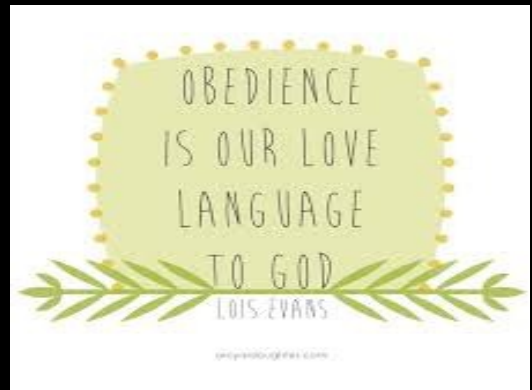
This letter is from a person who received one of our shoeboxes 8 years ago and found us recently on face book:
