

“How to Take Comfort in the Lord’s Priestly Intercession”

Psalm 110:1-7 11/11/18

Studies in the Psalms- Finding Comfort for Life

Big Idea- Jesus has been exalted to the highest place of honor and daily serves as our priest making intercession on our behalf (Heb 7:25; Rom 8:34). He will return again to make all things right (Rev 19:11-19; Isaiah 9:6-7; 63:1-7).

LESSON 1- We can take comfort in Jesus’ intercession due to God’s PROMISE

- A. God’s promise is given to Jesus who is more than just a MAN (Romans 1:3-4; Isaiah 9:6; Hebrews 1:3-13; **Matthew 22:41-45**)
- B. God’s promise is guaranteed because of Jesus’ EXALTATION (Mark 16:19; Acts 2:33-36; 5:31; Philippians 2:9-11; Eph 1:20)
- C. God’s promise is demonstrated by Him fulfilling His PLAN (Hebrews 10:13; 1 Corinthians 15:24-28; Daniel 2:44; Ps 110:2-3)

Going Deeper God wants us to trust in Jesus’ work because God can’t lie!

LESSON 2- We can take comfort in Jesus’ intercession due to God’s Priesthood

- A. God’s priesthood is given to Jesus permanently after MELCHIZEDEK (Gen 14:18-20; Zech 6:12-13; Heb 5:6-10; 6:20; 7:1-28; **10:11-14**)

Going Deeper God wants us to take comfort that Jesus is ALWAYS protecting us!

LESSON 3- We can take comfort in Jesus’ intercession due to God’s POWER

- A. God’s power is demonstrated in the surety of the King’s VICTORY (Isaiah 63:1-7; 61:1-2; 34:8; Revelation 3:21; 19:11-19)

Going Deeper God wants us to trust in His promise to make the world right in the end!
