Studies in the Psalms- Finding Comfort for Life

Big Idea- Even if the world or universe itself was destroyed, our God reigns and will protect His Children.

A song of the children of Korah- Psalms 42, 44-49; 84-88; **2 Chronicles 20:19**

LESSON 1- We can have radical faith when we trust in God’s PRESENCE

- A. God’s presence brings us confidence because He is our BOMB SHELTER (Psalm 46:1; 14:6; 61:4; 62:8-9; 71:7; 91:2, 9)
- B. God’s presence brings us confidence because He is our STRENGTH (Psalm 46:1; 8:2; 21:1; 28:7-8; 29:11; 2 Corinthians 12:7-10; Neh 8:10)
- C. God’s presence is always immediately available in every TROUBLE
- D. God’s presence should cause us to affirm that we will not FEAR (Psalm 27:1; 56:11; Isaiah 41:10; Matt 10:31; John 12:15; Heb 13:6)

Going Deeper God wants us to turn to Him always in the midst of trouble!

LESSON 2- We can have radical faith when we trust in God’s PROTECTION

- A. God’s protection in our lives is seen in that He is always WITH US (God of Armies is with us- 2 Kings 6; Isaiah 7:14; 8:8; Matt 1:23)

Going Deeper God wants us to respond in faith and praise in the midst of trouble!

LESSON 3- We can have radical faith when we trust in God’s PROPHECY

- A. God’s prophecy is that He will be the prince of PEACE (Isaiah 9:6-7; Micah 4:3; Isaiah 63:1-3; Rev 19:11-16)
- B. God’s prophecy should cause all people to BE STILL

Going Deeper God wants us to cease our strivings and demonstrate radical faith!
