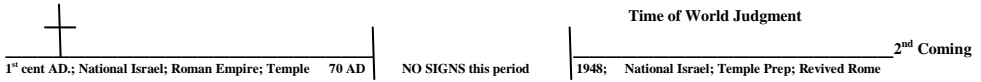


“The Two Responses to Jesus’ 2nd Coming” 9/29/19

Studies in 2 Peter- “Avoiding the Snare of False Teaching”



LESSON 1- Jesus’ 2nd coming brings about the response of the **SCOFFERS**

- A. Peter is warning us of the **FACT** of the scoffers.
(Jude 1:17-19; 1 Tim 4:1-3; 2 Tim 3:1-4:5; Matt 13:55; Luke 4:22)
- B. Peter is warning us of the **MOTIVATIONS** of the scoffers.
(Jude 1:18; 2 Peter 2:10, 13-14, 18; Romans 1:18-22; 2:5; Rom 14:10)
- C. Peter is warning us of the **PHILOSOPHY** of the scoffers.
(Ps 94:6-7; 10:11; Is 29:15; Ezek 8:12; 9:9; Zeph 1:12)
- D. Peter is giving us **GOD’S RESPONSE** to the scoffers.
(2 Peter 3:9; 15; **Rom 2:4-8**; Ezek 33:11; Rev 2:21; 9:20-21; 16:9-11)

LESSON 2- Jesus’ 2nd coming brings about the response of the **SAINTS**

- A. Peter is challenging us as saints to be walking in **HOLINESS**
(1 John 2:3-6; 3:3; John 14:15, 21; 1 Peter 1:15-16)
- B. Peter is challenging us as saints to be **EXPECTANT**
(Mat 24:42-43; 25:10-13; 25:13; Luke 12:39; 21:36; Rev 3:3)
- C. Peter is challenging us as saints to be **ZEALOUS**
(2 Tim 4:8; Rom 8:23; 2 Cor 5:2; 1 Thess 1:10; Titus 2:13; Rev 22:17)
- D. Peter is challenging us as saints to be found **READY**
(2 Cor 5:10; Rom 14:10; 1 Cor 3:1-5; Luke 19:11-17; Matt 25:14-30)
- E. Peter is giving us as saints **GOD’S RESPONSE**
(2 Cor 5:18-21; 2 Cor 2:16; Col 4:6; 1 Peter 3:15; 2 Tim 4:5)

Discipleship *A disciple will be actively looking for His return and live accordingly!*

It is important for God's people to recognize the difference between the rapture and the Second Coming. The rapture is when Jesus comes and catches His saints and removes them from the world. The Second coming is when Jesus arrives personally and bodily to interrupt this world's systems and to establish His 1000 year earthly reign beginning in Jerusalem.

Rapture

1. Translation of all believers
2. Raptured saints go to heaven
3. Earth not judged
4. Imminent; no pre-signs
5. Not in Old Testament
6. Affects believers only
7. Before the day of wrath
8. No reference to Satan
9. Christ comes *for* his own
10. He comes in the *air*
11. He claims His bride
12. Only His own see
13. Tribulation begins after
14. Church believers resurrected

Second Coming

- No translation at all (into heaven)
- Saints return to earth
- Earth judged; righteousness established
- Only after many definite signs (Tribulation)
- Predicted very much in Old Testament
- Affects all mankind on earth
- Concludes the day of wrath
- Satan bound for 1000 years
- Christ comes *with* his own
- He comes to the *earth*
- He comes with His wife
- Every eye shall see Him
- Millennium begins after
- Old Testament saints resurrected
