Unseen Realm: Session 35- Final Wrap Up, The Reclaiming of Nations, Final Elohim Assault

The Reclaiming of the Nations

- ESV **Deuteronomy 32:8-9** When the Most High gave **to the nations their inheritance, when he <u>divided</u> mankind**, he fixed the borders of the peoples according to the number of the sons of God. ⁹ But the LORD's portion is his people, Jacob his allotted heritage. (see Acts 2:3 NKJV, "divided") ("confused" Acts 2:6 NKJV; Genesis 11:7, 9)
- ESV Acts 17:26 And he made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place, ²⁷ that they should seek God, and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him. Yet he is actually not far from each one of us,
- ESV **Psalm 82:1-2** *A Psalm of Asaph.* God has taken his place in the divine council; in the midst of the gods he holds judgment: ² "How long will you judge unjustly and show partiality to the wicked? Selah
- NET **Psalm 82:6-8** I thought, 'You are gods; all of you are sons of the Most High.' ⁷ Yet you will die like mortals; you will fall like all the other rulers." ⁸ <u>Rise up, O God</u>, and execute judgment on the earth! For <u>you</u> own all the nations. (or you shall inherit the nations).
- ESV Acts 2:8-11 And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language? 9 Parthians and Medes and Elamites and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, 10 Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, 11 both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabians—we hear them telling in our own tongues the mighty works of God."
- ESV Romans 15:28 When therefore I have completed this and have delivered to them what has been collected, I will leave for Spain by way of you.
- ESV Isaiah 66:18 ¶ "For I know their works and their thoughts, and the time is coming to gather all nations and tongues. And they shall come and shall see my glory, ¹⁹ and I will set a sign among them. And from them I will send survivors to the nations, to Tarshish, Pul, and Lud, who draw the bow, to Tubal and Javan, to the coastlands far away, that have not heard my fame or seen my glory. And they shall declare my glory among the nations.

The Final Son of Perdition and Unseen Realm Assault

- ESV Genesis 3:14 The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, cursed are you above all livestock and above all beasts of the field; on your belly you shall go, and <u>dust</u> you shall eat all the days of your life. ¹⁵ I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your <u>offspring</u> and her <u>offspring</u>; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."
- ESV 2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no one deceive you in any way. For that day will not come, unless the rebellion comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the <u>son</u> of destruction, ⁴ who opposes and exalts himself against every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, proclaiming himself to be God. (John 17:12; Luke 22:3)
- ESV **Revelation 9:1** ¶ And the fifth angel blew his trumpet, and I saw a star fallen from heaven to earth, and he was given the key to the shaft of the bottomless pit. ² He opened the shaft of the bottomless pit, and from the shaft rose smoke like the smoke of a great furnace, and the sun and the air were darkened with the smoke from the shaft. ³ Then from the smoke came locusts on the earth, and they were given power like the power of scorpions of the earth. ⁴ They were told not to harm the grass of the earth or any green plant or any tree, but only those people who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads. ⁵ They were allowed to torment them for five months, but not to kill them, and their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it stings someone. ⁶ And in those days people will seek death and will not find it. They will long to die, but death will flee from them. ⁷ ¶ In appearance the locusts were like horses prepared for battle: on their heads were what looked like crowns of gold; their faces were like human faces, ⁸ their hair like women's hair, and their teeth like lions' teeth; ⁹ they had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the noise of their wings was like the noise of many chariots with horses rushing into battle. ¹⁰ They have tails and stings like scorpions, and their power to hurt people for five months is in their tails. ¹¹ They have as king over them the angel of the bottomless pit. His name in Hebrew is Abaddon, and in Greek he is called Apollyon.
