Colossians 2:10-15

Studies in Colossians- “The Supremacy and Sufficiency of Jesus the Messiah”

“And you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.”
Colossians 2:10

Complete: having all parts or elements; lacking nothing; whole; entire; full; having all required or customary characteristics, skills, or the like.

LESSON 1- To be complete in Jesus we must demonstrate a life that is **NEW**

- A. Being complete in Jesus shows us that we have a new **HEART**
(Gen 17:10-14; Deut 30:6; Jer 4:4; 9:26; Acts 7:51; Ezek 36:26; 44:9)

“The heart is deceitful above all things, And desperately wicked; Who can know it?” Jeremiah 17:9

“I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.” Ezekiel 36:26

- B. Being complete in Jesus shows us that we have a new **LIFE**
(Ephesians 2:1-3; 4-7; 2 Corinthians 2:16; Galatians 2:20; Rom 6:4)
Spiritually dead- unable to respond to any sort of spiritual stimuli; helpless.
New Life- loving God, worship, prayer, learning, loving others, sacrifice, monetary generosity, heart for lost, excitement for His return

- C. Being complete in Jesus shows us that we have a new **FREEDOM**
(Gal 3:10; 13; Heb 8:8; Psalm 130:3-4; Acts 26:18; Matt 3:2; 4:17)

“If You, LORD, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand?” Ps 130:3

“Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, Whose sin is covered.” Ps 32:1

- D. Being complete in Jesus shows us that we have a new **VICTORY**
(Acts 26:18; Hebrews 2:14; 1 Peter 5:8; Ephesians 6:11-18)
