Safe the Date

Pass-through Scam Alert from the Federal Trade Commission's Consumer Information Section.

Have you gotten a recorded phone message from "Susie" with the "Vehicle Service Department" calling about your vehicle warranty? That's like, so retro. But fanny packs, scrunchies, and tie dye are back — and so are vehicle warranty robocalls.

It starts when you pick up a call and hear a recorded message saying something about your vehicle's manufacturer's warranty. It might say that they have sent you several notices in the mail. They say you haven't extended your warranty past the factory cut off, and they're going to close your file soon if you don't respond. And, you should press a number if you're interested in renewing your warranty, or press a **different** number if you want to be removed from the list.

(*Note – asking to be removed from the list does not remove you from the list. It confirms that there is a live person on the other end of the number which will likely increase calls, not stop them.)

Slam on the brakes. This is an illegal robocall and likely a scam. The companies behind this type of robocall are not with your car dealer or manufacturer, and the "extended warranty" they're trying to sell you is actually a service contract that often sells for hundreds or thousands of dollars. If you buy it, you may find that the contract doesn't actually cover any problems you have with your car because of the restrictions in the fine print.

If you get one of these calls:

Hang up. Don't engage with a company that reaches you with an illegal call.

Consider using an app or device to block unwanted calls. Learn more about how to do that.

Report the robocall at DoNotCall.gov.

The results were amazing: 697 services, 156 decisions for Christ, 162 volunteers from 32 different churches and ministries, marking a new record in participation. One of the dreams of our founding father Dr. Cesar Tamez was to see the body of Christ working together as one. We thank all the volunteers that made this possible!"

Thank you to all who continue to support the work in Mexico. The demand for supplies (including knitted items) is endless and your contributions have helped keep us stocked up for the event.

We celebrated the official end of our 2020-2021 school year last week and we are all very excited to begin our new summer program! Once upon a time, In the Beginning: A Summer of Classic Stories & The 7 days of Creation. (Details on the stories and days of creation are posted on the Ministry bulletin board located in the Church entryway.)

We are so blessed to have such a wonderful teaching staff this summer: Theresa DeGraffenreid, Bonni Leon, Balin Usher, and also, my husband, substitute teacher Thomas Tran. Thank you to everyone who helped to honor each of them last month on Teacher Appreciation Sunday. We have lost teachers during this last year due to Covid, health concerns, relocation, and other factors that contribute to the normal turnover in the field. Although we miss those who have moved on to other adventures, we are very grateful for whatever length of time each of our former teachers was able to serve in this ministry and trust that they will reap heavenly rewards for their time here.

We do have openings for more teachers so please be in prayer that God will fill those positions as the summer progresses. Once our downstairs classroom renovation is complete and we are able to enroll infants and toddlers, we will need eight full time teachers to meet our licensed capacity of 50 children. Meanwhile, with one full time and three part time teachers, we needed to reduce our hours for the summer (see bulletin board for details) to accommodate the 24 children who are currently enrolled. Yet we are grateful to God who continues to meet our daily needs by surprising us with additional help when we most need it! We look forward to welcoming Sarah Flannagan as a volunteer Reader and Holly Brumbach as an Introduction to Spanish Teacher. Please pray that their paperwork is completed quickly and easily so that they will be able to join us soon! Please also pray that our infant toddler classroom and playground are completed quickly. We have families who are ready to enroll as soon as we are able to open.
